EXPRESS

Express Collective is our pioneering creative and therapeutic arts programme addressing challenges affecting vulnerable young people. We enable young people to choose an issue and a creative medium in which to explore solutions. DreamArts delivers a tailor-made project to meet their need, empowering them to make positive life choices.
