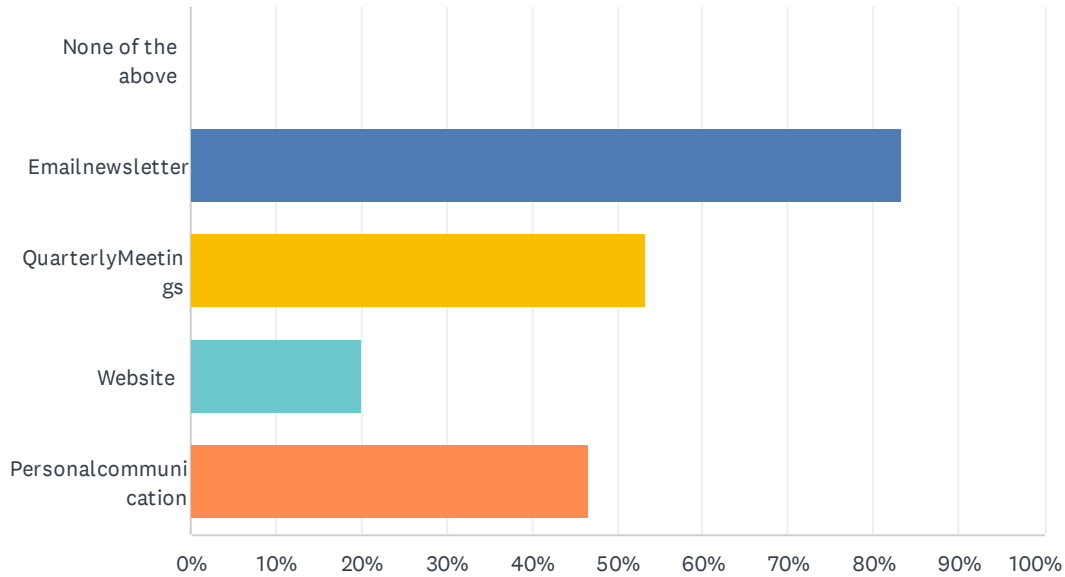


# Q1 How do you receive information from the BME Health Forum? (Please tick all that apply)

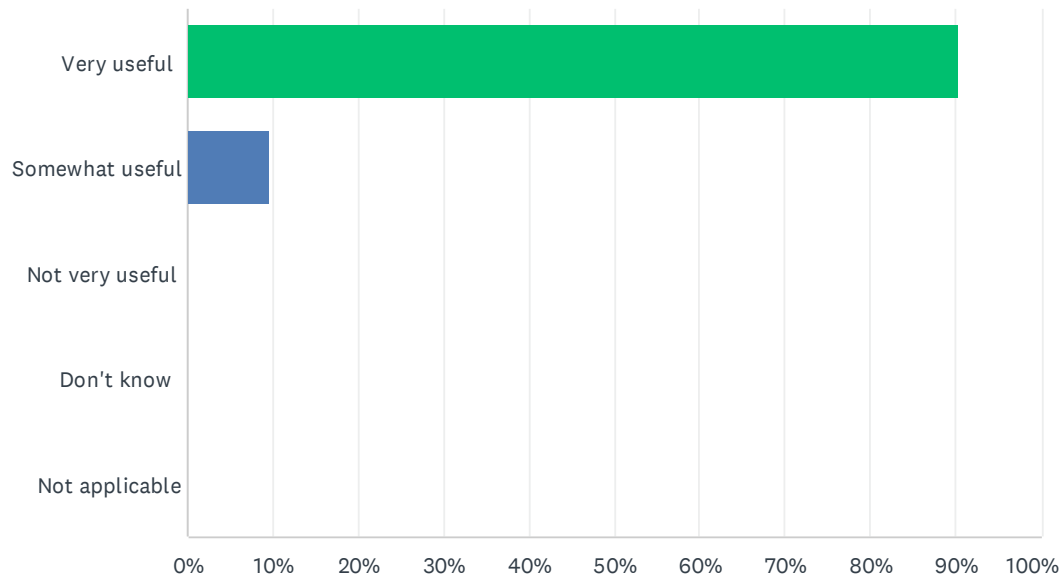

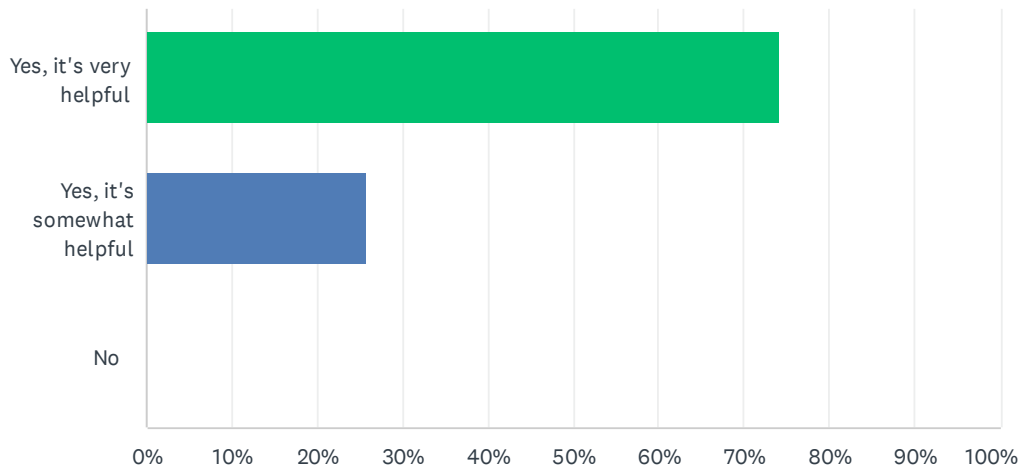

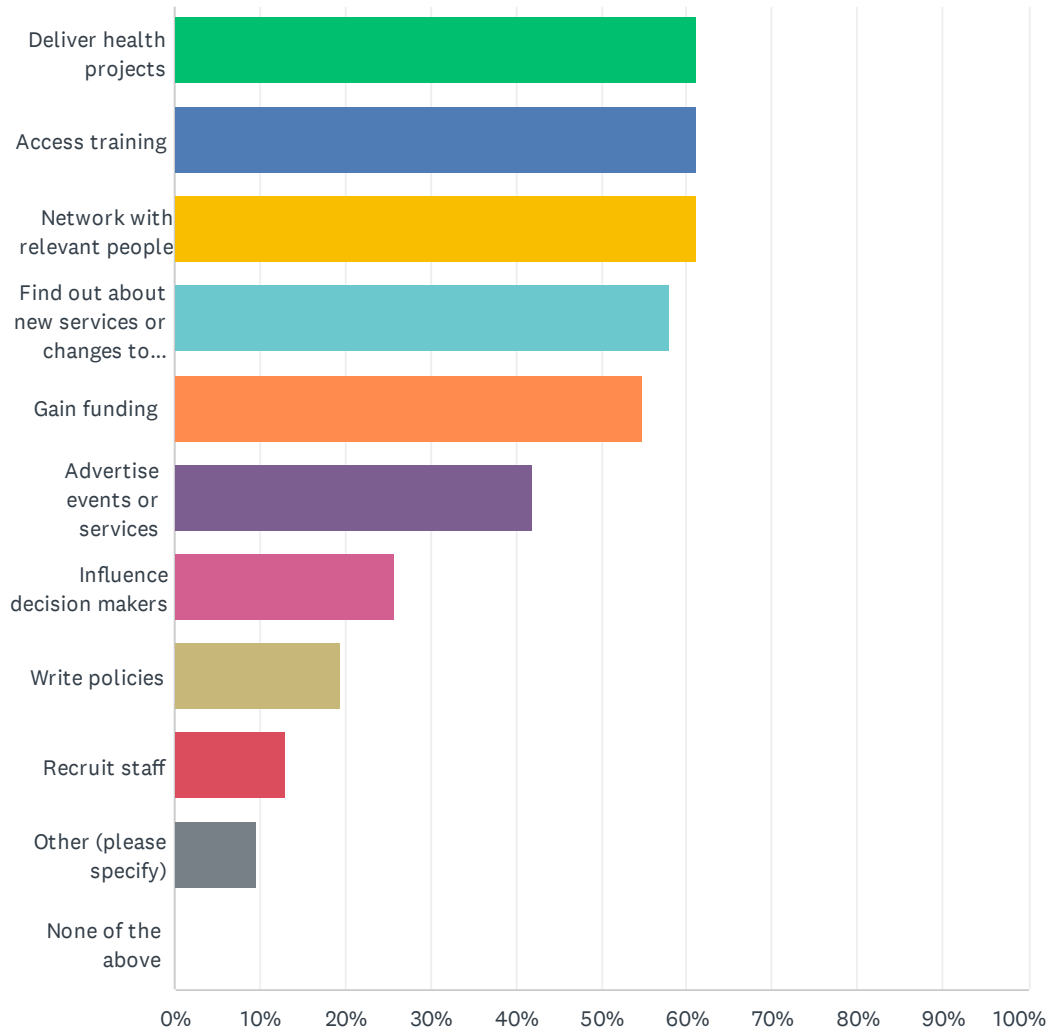

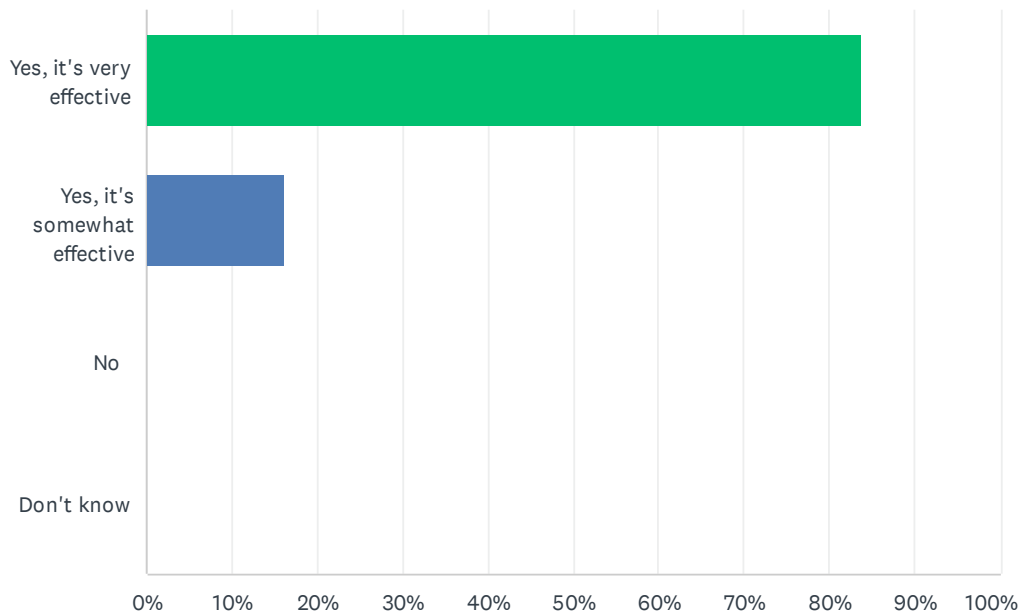

## Q5 Do you think that the BME Health Forum acts effectively as an advocate of BME organisations and communities in matters relating to health and race?

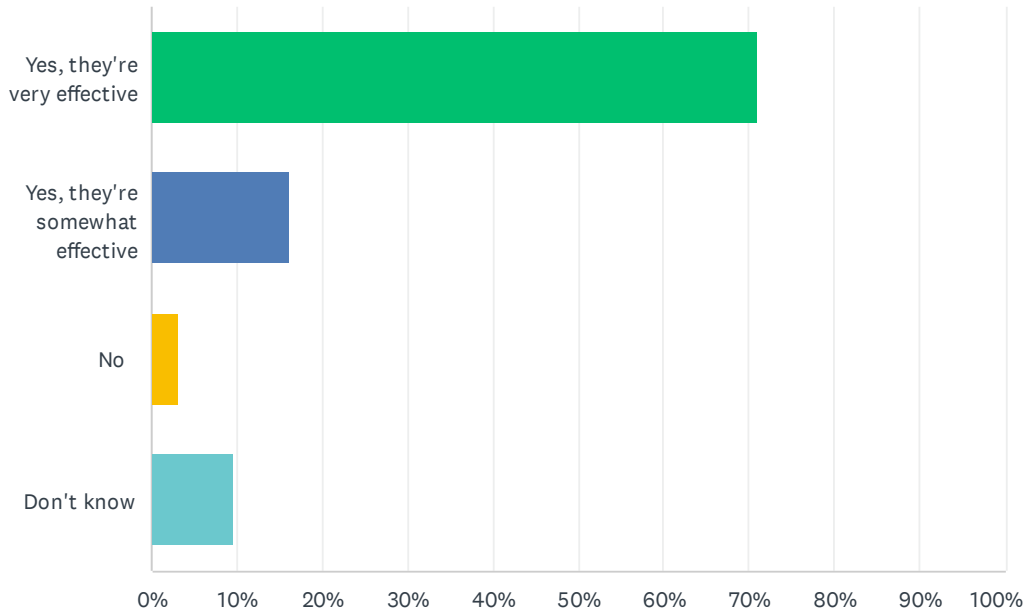

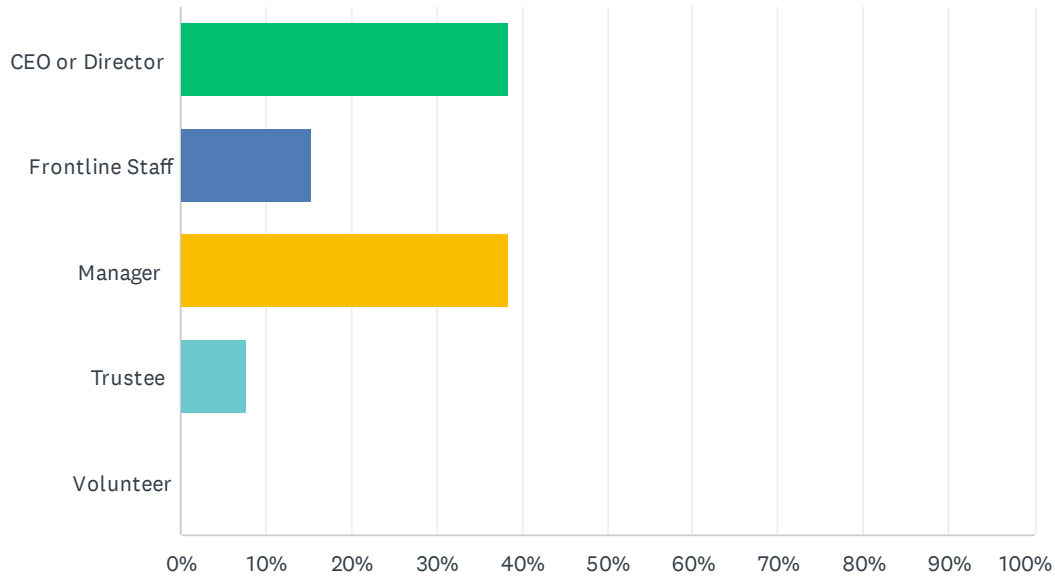
