London Resilient Communities is a programme that supports the capital's voluntary, community and faith sectors to:

- Develop Community Emergency Plans
- Become Community Resilience Hubs

This programme will offer voluntary, community and faith sector partners:

- **Free online support** including videos, templates and other resources to help you develop Community Emergency Plans or become a Community Resilience Hub.
- Small grants that will open for applications in **November 2025** to support you. There will be two grants available as follows:
 - Developing a Community Emergency Plan: **£500**
 - Becoming a Community Resilience Hub: **£1,000**

Successful applicants will also have access to a series of online sessions providing further expert support, and the opportunity to network with their fellow grantees.
